

# Guide to the Life '26 resources and your church account

When you register your church for Life '26, you'll have full access to our resources — all designed to help your church get ready to make the most out of being part of the nationwide gospel mission beginning next March.

## Accessing resources using your church account

To access the full-length personal witness training videos and accompanying materials, and the full range of Life '26 resources, you will need to [login](#) with your email address or username and password. If you need it, there is a 'Forgot Password' link on the login page.

## Creating and using sub-accounts

Sub-accounts can be created to give other people in the church access to the personal witness training videos. Importantly, people who are logged in with a sub-account will not be able to view or change your church registration details.

**You can either create a single sub-account and share the login details with those who need them; or you can create up to 20 sub-accounts using different email addresses.**

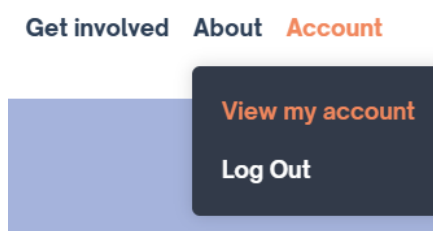
By default, sub-accounts allow view-only access to the Personal Witness Training Videos for Church and Congregation Members. This is primarily intended to allow people who miss small group sessions to catch-up with watching the videos.

For those who need to be able to download the videos (e.g. Ministry or Small Group Leaders) you are free to share your main church account login details with them. Alternatively, you can create a sub-account for these group leaders and contact us and ask us to grant download permissions for this sub-account. (You will need to supply the email address for the sub-account in question.)

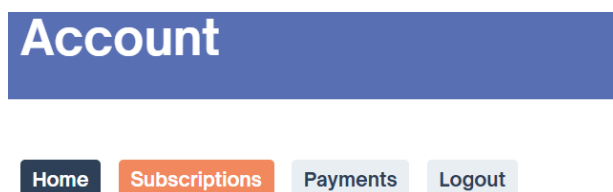
## How to create one or more sub-accounts

First you need to log-in to our website with your church login details. When you are logged in, '**Account**' will appear in the main menu (top right of screen).

Hovering over this will open up the option to '**View my account**':



Click on '**View my account**' and you should be taken to a page with four tabs. Next, click on '**Subscriptions**':



Under '**Subscriptions**', you can create new sub-accounts and also manage existing sub-accounts. As stated above, you can either create a single sub-account and then share the login details with those who need them. Or you can create up to 20 sub-accounts using different email addresses. The holder of the email address will receive an email requesting them to set up a password for the sub-account that is being created.

Return to the Subscriptions tab of this Account area whenever you want to create a new sub-account or manage an existing sub-account. And please [contact us](#) if you wish to request download permissions for one or more sub-accounts you have created.

### Personal Witness Training Modules



Our suite of 29 [Personal Witness Training Sessions](#) have been carefully designed to help Christians to grow in their confidence and competence in sharing the gospel. The sessions are grouped in four categories (*Beginning with the Bible; Connecting with People; Starting Out; Going Further*) to help you to navigate such a large suite of sessions.

For each session, there is a short **preview video** or, if you are logged in, you can watch the **full-length video** and/or download a **summary and transcript**.

You can also [download a guide to the resources](#). Printed copies of this resource guide are available for purchase from [The Good Book Company](#). As a subscriber church, you are entitled to one free copy of the booklet – use the code **LIFE26SUBS** at checkout to claim your copy with free postage. When ordering your free copy, you can add further copies to the order and still get free delivery for the whole order. We recommend ordering multiple copies for your leadership and/or planning teams to look over.

After reviewing the resources, simply select the sessions you want to use with your church or small group. Alternatively, you could use/adapt one of our recommended series. We have also provided a plan for using all the sessions over a one to three-year period.

Each session, led by one of our presenters, comes with a leader's guide for an hour-long session with suggested Bible study questions and prayer points, and a printable handout for participants. The handout is designed to help group participants to take notes whilst watching the video.

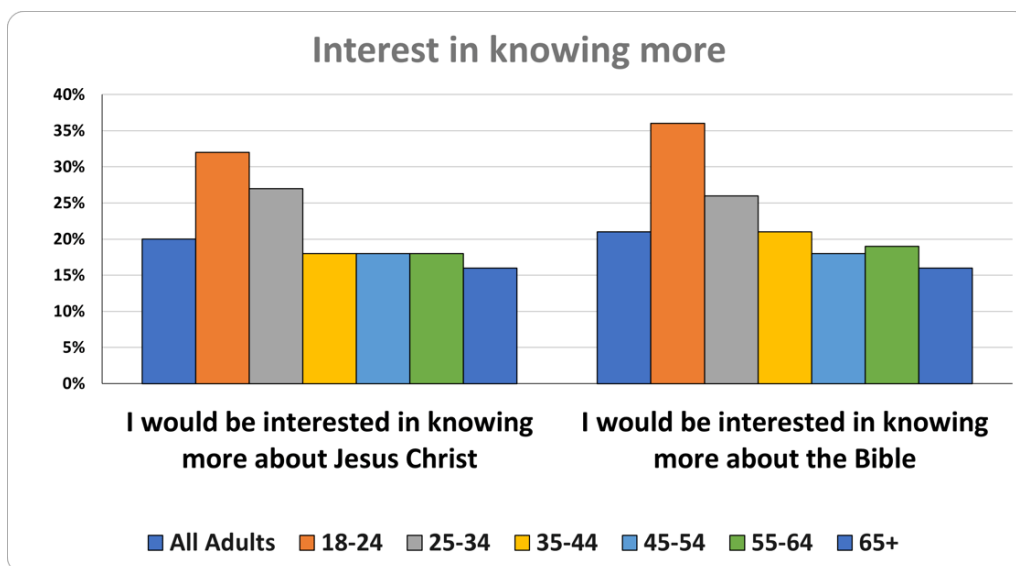
**For each session, you can download the separate files or download a single zip file with the video and all the written resources.**

*Please note that if you left-click on the video download link, the video will most likely start to play in your browser. You will then need to click on the three dots at the bottom-right-hand corner of the player and select the download option. Alternatively, right-click on the download link and choose 'save link as'.*

## Survey Resources

In the Summer of 2025, we commissioned [our own national research](#) and we were amazed at the results. There really is great encouragement and there are some big implications for our evangelism. We asked:

- What people would say is missing from their lives
- Their church attendance and interest in finding out more about Jesus
- Their openness to attending church services and events



We've created a **Survey Toolkit** to help you **conduct your own research** in your local area. The results might surprise you and inform your thinking as you plan your local mission as part of LIFE '26.

The information you gather can be valuable in **shaping your mission and publicity** – and the very act of conducting a survey can open up fresh evangelistic opportunities and start conversations!

Our Survey Kit helps you gather information on the following:

- How people in your local area are feeling about their lives and what they would say is missing from their lives
- Their beliefs
- Their experiences and perception of church
- Their interest in finding out more about Jesus and the Bible, and their openness to attending church services and events

## Finding People for your Mission

But also consider who you know locally and ask your regional gospel partnership or other churches in your area for recommendations.

Just be aware of the small print:

We have also asked the people included in this directory to affirm the Evangelical Alliance Statement of Faith and our own statement on a biblical understanding of human sexuality and marriage. However, we cannot do any due diligence beyond that. So please see this list as a starting point, and do the research needed to be confident that speakers and others you invite to contribute to a church service or event will meet your doctrinal standards and will be able to connect with your intended audience. You should also make sure you follow your church and/or denomination's policy for inviting speakers.*

If you want to invite someone listed in the directory, please fill in the online form that you can access by clicking 'more info'. This will be forwarded on to them, and you'll also be sent a copy of the message with them copied in so that you can contact them directly about your event.
